


The OIA is undertaking an investigation: What to expect



At any of the stages identified in yellow the subject councillor or a legal representative may contact the investigating officer and advise that they agree with the allegation made and the matter may be immediately referred to the tribunal, by consent and based on an agreed statement of facts. The fact that the councillor has co-operated in this fashion is something that the CCT may take into account in determining sanction. The earlier this happens in the investigative process the greater the potential consideration in relation to the sanction.
